ALL PARTICIPATING UNITS MUST REGISTER ON SIGNUP GENIUS.

Enter to Ride on the Winning Float:

Each Unit who registers to march in the Parade by December 1 at 9pm will be entered into a competition to have one Scout from their Pack ride on the float. Each Unit will decide on the specific Scout (random drawing suggested). Winners will be notified by email.

Parade Uniform:

Units should have at least 50% of their Scouts in the Field Uniform. The remaining Scouts can be in the Unit Activity shirt. Units can have everyone wear Field Uniform, if preferred. All Adult Leaders should wear their full Field Uniform; parents can wear Activity T-Shirt.

OA Members should wear their sash and can add any ceremonial dress.

Scout Spirit:

Scouts and adults are invited to add a Scout theme to their uniform. Examples of themes are wearing a Paper-Mache canoe with oars, riding bikes, carrying rope for rappelling or binoculars, holding Pinewood Derby cars and rockets, carrying skis, etc. Need ideas? TROOPS & CREWS

Each Troop or Crew in Northern Lights is invited to compete to have their design selected for the Parade Float.

Prize

Rules & Guidelines:

- Float design competition is only open to Troops or Crews.
- No limit to the number of entries from each Troop or Crew.
- Entry must be designed by Boy Scouts or Venturers only – no adult entries!
- Winning float must fit on a standard flatbed trailer. Winners can provide their own flatbed trailer.
- Design must allow for 8 Scouts to safely ride on the float. Per BSA Guidelines, Scouts must have legs inside float (not hanging over side) and be able to securely hold onto something stationary.
- Design must be Scout-themed!
- All supplies are to be provided by Unit. Pallets and heavy-duty cardboard boxes are available, if needed.

How to enter:

- Bring entry to the November 11 Roundtable. NO entries accepted after this date.
- Designs can be drawings or small mock-ups.
- All designs must be identified by Troop Name/Designer(s) and contact information in a sealed envelope attached to the design.

Winner will be announced by email by November 14.
