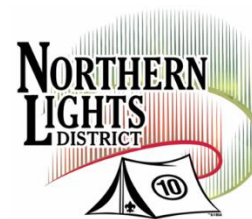


District Recognition Dinner

We will be honoring our **2017 Eagle Scouts** and **Arrow of Light** recipients, plus... our **Outstanding Adult Volunteers**.

This event is open to volunteer leaders, family members, and Scouts of all ages!

Youth awards will be made for the **Arrowman of the Year**, and for **Outstanding Eagle Project(s)**.

Adult Volunteer Awards include:

- District Award of Merit – A Council-level award, available to registered Scouters who render service of an outstanding nature at the district level.
- Astronomer Award - This award was designed to recognize the Individuals in the Northern Lights District that have gone above and beyond to assure the success in recruiting and retaining of boys, in their programs.
- Aurora Borealis Award - This award is given to one Pack, one Troop and one Crew with distinguished unit accomplishment that provides exemplary service within the Northern Lights District community as a group.
- Golden Compass Award - Golden Compass Award was created to recognize the quality unit leaders.
- Lighthouse Award - This award is presented to a husband and wife, who have both made significant contributions to youth over two or more years.
- Luminaries Volunteer Award - The award is presented annually (one per every 10 youth registered in a unit) to those Scouters, or non-registered friends of a Scouting unit, who have made a contribution of significance to that unit.
- Pegasus Award - The Pegasus award is meant to recognize noteworthy and sustained service given at the unit or district level by a registered commissioner within the Northern Lights District.
- Polaris Award - The Polaris Award recognizes outstanding contributions and service by adult committee volunteers to the Scouting program.
