

Camp James Ray Directions

To Pack 235,

If you would like even more specific directions, please see below:

Take 75 North towards Oklahoma

Exit on 120 West towards Pottsboro

continue through Pottsboro and West on FM 996 (turns into Cook's Corner Road)

make left on Locust Rd.

take right onto Mill Creek Rd.

Stay on Mill Creek until you can see Mill Creek Resort Rd. on right

You will see Camp James Ray entrance!

 - We have reserved the Lone Eagle and Apache camp areas. Click on map on website. It took us about 1 hour and 20 minutes to get there from Plano. There is a parking lot when you first enter Camp James Ray. We are allowed to drive to the camp site to unload/load only. Then we have to park our vehicles in the parking lot and walk back to the camp site area. We do not have electrical access at our campsite, so please plan accordingly.

 - The \$10 camping fee per family is going towards food for the Pack at the camp out on Saturday and Sunday. (Friday evening each family is on their own for supper). Saturday's meals and Sunday morning will be prepared by Pack cooking if you wish to partake. Anyone with a camping stove and/or fuel is urged to bring your equipment to help with our Pack's ability to heat water and cook food during meal times. Also, camp tables will be needed as well as buckets and wash basins. If you have any of this equipment you are willing to bring and share, please let me know so I can pass on this info to our Cubmaster. We urge everyone to bring their own plastic or metal plate, bowl, cup and utensils. After washing them, they dry and store easy by hanging them up in a mesh bag.
