

## Pack Overnight Family Camp-out Checklist

-Please camp in designated camping area and park in designated areas.

### Bring the following items for each Cub Scout, Sibling and Parent:

- Refillable water bottle
- Mess kit:  
plate, bowl, cup, knife, fork, spoon
- Flashlight
- Hat
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Sleeping bag, pillow
- Air mattress, Cot or Sleeping pad
- Rain gear – poncho or FroggToggs recommended
- Warm jacket, sweatshirt
- A change of clothes
- Toothpaste, toothbrush, soap etc.
- Towels and washcloth
- Durable shoes (bring extra!) - must enclose both toes and heel of foot.  
**Note: most sandals, and cros do not meet this requirement.**
- Flip flops/Slide sandals for shower time only
- Snacks
- All daily medications

### Each family should bring the following items:

- Tent (If you need to borrow a tent, please talk with your Unit Leader)
- Ground sheet for under your tent

### Optional Items

- Camera
- Folding chair **Recommended!**
- Lantern
- Binoculars
- Sunglasses
- Place a change of clothing in Ziploc bags to keep dry
- Compass
- Long fork or hangers for roasting marshmallows
- Notebook and pencil
- Pack of cards or other compact board game
- Wet wipes
- Extra snack food items or special dietary requirements
- Cub Scout may bring a pocketknife with parental consent, AND they must have their **whittling chip** on their person.

### **DO NOT BRING**

- Hatchet, or Axe
- Cub Scout should not bring their pocketknife unless they have earned their whittling chip and have the chip on their person.
- Fireworks
- Alcohol
- Firearms
- IPODS/ Nintendo's DS's, DVD players etc. lets spend time together!

### Important Notes:

Propane lanterns, open flame and heaters are not permitted in tents.

No Smoking: Tobacco in any form, this includes the use of electronic cigarettes, personal vaporizers, or electronic nicotine delivery systems that simulate

tobacco smoking is not permitted at any BSA activity involving youth participants.
